MAINE APPALOOSA YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP FUND OF NEW ENGLAND

ALL APPLICATIONS DUE ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 31st.

The MAINE APPALOOSA YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP FUND OF NEW ENGLAND will award at least one youth educational scholarship of \$400.00 each year. A first alternate will be designated and will receive a scholarship should a winner not use his/her award in the period stipulated.

Applicants must be a member of the Maine Appaloosa Horse Club.

Scholarships are awarded annually, preceding the school year for which they must be used. The check from the scholarship fund will be payable to the recipient during the second semester of college. It is non-transferable from the person receiving the award, and must be used within one year from the date of the award. If not used, it will be awarded to the first alternate or revert back to the scholarship fund.

Additionally, the application must be made on an official application form and must be filled out and signed by the person applying for the scholarship. It is to each applicant's advantage to submit a very complete, neat, and informative application.

Scholarship selection is based upon scholastic aptitude; involvement in the Appaloosa industry; leadership potential; sportsmanship; community and civic responsibility; and general knowledge and accomplishments in horsemanship.

In order to apply for this scholarship, the applicant must hold a high school diploma or equivalent certification; or be anticipating high school graduation this year. GPA must be at least a 2.5 on 4.0 scale or a 3.8 on 6.0 scale. An official grade transcript from the applicant's most recent high school or college must accompany this application.

This application must be completed and received by the scholarship committee by August 31st in order to be considered by the scholarship selection committee.

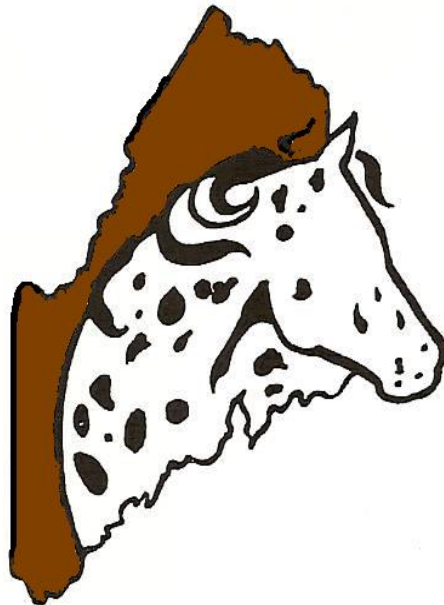
