SHOW RULES & REGULATION

1. No horse is eligible to participate in the Regional pointed show unless it is registered with the Appaloosa Horse Club in Moscow, ID. **This does not apply to the All-Breed classes.**
2. All ApHC exhibitors, except Leadline and Walk-Trot must enter an open class in order to take advantage of the blanket fee.
3. All Regional Exhibitors [this includes trainers & owners of horses being shown] must show proof of ApHC membership to the Show Secretary before entering any regional classes. **This does not apply for the All-Breed classes.**
4. State of Maine Law requires proof of **Negative Coggins Test:** Maine horses within three [3] years, **Out-of- State horses within six [6] months of show date.**
5. All entries must be made on official entry forms & be signed by the proper parties. Each horse will have one "responsible party" assigned for payment. No splitting of fees in the office.
6. Refund or credit requests are to be made in writing to the Maine Appaloosa Horse Club Show Manager. A decision will be made at the next Board of Directors Meeting. Veterinarian certificate is required for full refund.
7. **All classes (including All-Breed classes)** will be conducted in accordance with the Appaloosa Horse Club's Show Rules & Regulations listed in the Official Handbook. You can find this handbook on the Appaloosa Horse Club website, www.appaloosa.com or in the show office. **All Breed classes will follow ApHC rules.**
8. Ribbons or prizes will be awarded for all classes.
9. **Weekend Champion and Reserve Champion Awards: Must show in at least three (3) classes in a division to qualify for weekend awards.**

Appaloosa Division Awards: Youth Walk-Trot 10 & Under; Youth 18 & Under, Non-Pro; Non-Pro 35 Years & Over; Non-Pro Masters; Non-Pro Walk-Trot; Performance Horse
All Breed Division Awards: All Breed Youth Leadline Division, All Breed Youth 18 & Under; All Breed Walk-Trot Youth 11 & Under; All Breed Walk-Trot Youth 12-18; All Breed Non-Pro/Amateur Adult (19 & Over); All Breed Non-Pro/Amateur Walk-Trot Adult (19 & Over); All Breed Open & Professional Adult (19 & Over)
Ties for Champion (high point) & Reserve Champion (hi point) Awards will be broken by highest number of blue ribbons. If there is still a tie it will go to red ribbons. If a tie remains it will go to the person earning the highest score of the call judge. If a tie remains after all three a coin will be flipped the winner will be awarded the high point award and the non-winner of the toss will receive the reserve award. No other reserve will be given.

9. **MAINE STATE LAW!** All dogs must be leashed at all times. This will be enforced.

CAMPER HOOK-UPS ARE AVAILABLE. MeApHC WILL BE COLLECTING CAMPER HOOK-UP FEES

Camper Spaces by the Arena are reserved for show management. No exceptions.

Directions – From south on I-95: Take the Skowhegan exit right onto Route 201. Proceed North into Skowhegan Staying on Route 201, go right at the light that will take you across two bridges & into downtown Skowhegan [one-way traffic]. Proceed on Route 201 up four-lane Madison Avenue until you see the signs for Walmart & Hannaford. The Skowhegan Fairgrounds & stores' entrance is on the left. **FROM NORTH ON I-95:** Exit off of I-95 at Newport. Travel into Skowhegan by Route 2. Turn right onto Madison Avenue. Follow above directions.
